Enhanced cooperation between HHRM and Technical University of Crete

Hellenic Hydrocarbon Resources Management (HHRM) and MSc in Petroleum Engineering of the School of Mineral Resources Engineering of the Technical University of Crete enhanced their scientific-research cooperation, within the framework of the two-year memorandum, signed in April 2017.

In particular, HHRM offers the possibility of two-month summer internships to postgraduate students, aiming at gaining experience through active participation in company projects. Moreover, scientific cooperation is scheduled, in the context of dissertations on hydrocarbon issues. Additionally, a program of seminars is under way, conducted by HHRM executives addressed to postgraduate students, throughout the academic year 2018-2019, to further develop the technical background of future executives in the field of exploration, production and exploitation of hydrocarbons.

These initiatives are in line with HHRM vision for the development of excellent human resources to meet the increased needs of industry in Greece and especially in Crete as a potentially significant energy hub in the Eastern Mediterranean.
