HHRM organises the Mediterranean Offshore Authorities Forum

Following the vision of strengthening regional cooperation in key sectors such as offshore safety, Hellenic Hydrocarbon Resources Management (HHRM S.A.) is launching another cross-border initiative and organizes the **Mediterranean Offshore Authorities Forum**, with the participation of the Competent Authorities for Offshore Safety from EU Mediterranean Countries (Croatia, Cyprus, Greece, Italy, Malta, Spain and Portugal), the Department of Public Works of the Ministry of Transport, Communications and Works of Cyprus and the Cyprus Hydrocarbons Company.
